## *The Code of Logues*

### *Stay Cool*

Campfires may be lit in a fire ring after 6pm in the evening but must be completely out by 10am.

Gas cookers can be used at anytime of the day.

**Campfires and gas cookers must be used on bare soil and 3 metres from any flammable material.**

### *Off-road vehicles and unlicensed vehicles*

All Roads in the Logue Brook Dam area are public roads and all vehicles driven must be:

- Registered for use on public roads (not as off-road vehicles)
- Driven or ridden by a person with a Motor Drivers License (MDL)
- Driven or ridden on formed roads (not through the bush or on tracks)

There are no public lands in the Logue Brook Dam area where off-road vehicle use is permitted.



### *Be in the right spot*

Camping areas are on the north and west shores of the dam and at the Caravan Park ONLY.

#### **Camping Fees Apply:**

\$7.00 Adult per night

\$5.00 Concession per night

\$2.00 Children (6 to 15 years old)



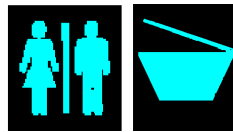
The south and east shores are for day use only. If you set up for the day on the south shore please make sure you're packed up and away by nightfall.



### *Be Clean - Be hygienic.*

Temporary skip bins (on long weekends) are located around the camping areas. Make sure you take your rubbish to the skip bins. If you need garbage bags ask the National Park Ranger.

Temporary toilets will be hired to cope with popularity on Long Weekends. Please use them.



### *Be safe on the water.*

Only ski in ski areas and keep well away from where people are swimming.

**Jet skis are not permitted unless they are towing a skier.**



Marine Safety Officers and Police Officers will carry out patrols this weekend to help everyone keep safe. All vessels should ensure that

appropriate safety equipment is on board and operators have a Recreational Skippers Ticket.

### *Be courteous*

Help keep Logues peaceful, keep the noise down at night after 10pm.

Help keep Logues as a place to take your dog. Keep your dog on a leash at all times and clean up your dog's poo.

### *About Logue Brook Dam.*

Any camping fees go towards providing facilities at Logues.

The Department of Environment and Conservation is planning for more permanent facilities here at Logues and we hope that next year you will see some worthwhile additions to make you stay even better.
